



Edmonton Required rules 2018

Participation Limit

Standard Crew division: **minimum four (4) to a maximum of ten (10) members**
But cannot overlap into megacrew division.

MegaCrew consists of a **minimum eleven (11) to a maximum of forty-five (45) members. But cannot overlap standard crew division.**

The members of the MegaCrew may be made up of any combination of males and females.

Age Requirement

Junior: Ages 7 to 12

Varsity: Ages 12 to 17

Adult: 18+

Megacrew: Mixed ages: This can be in Large groups exceeding over 10 dancers.

Props:

- Props are permitted.

Performance music requirements:

Routine length: **2:00min to 5:00min**

**Timing begins with the first audible sound (includes cueing beep) and ends with the last audible sound and/or dance sequence.*

EVALUATION

Performance = five points of the total score (50%)

- **Originality (10%)**
- **Staging, Spacing, Formations, and Level changes (10%)**
- **Authentic Presence/Attire (10%)**
- **Showmanship (10%)**
- **Entertainment Value/Crowd Appeal (10%)**

Skill = five points of the total score (50%)

- **Execution/controlled mobility and stabilization (10%)**
- **Synchronization (10%)**
- **Musicality (10%)Difficulty (10%)**



Edmonton Required rules 2018

- **Variety of Hip Hop Dance Styles (10%)** It is not mandatory to perform 2 styles, but to attain the highest score possible, a minimum of two (2) street dance styles must be performed in the routine to receive Variety points. The more correctly the styles are executed the higher the variety score will be.

Example: 1 style receives an automatic 2.5 points, but the better the style is executed, the higher the score can be. Up to a maximum of 4.99 points. If 2 styles are executed, an automatic 5 points is allocated up to a maximum of 10.00 for proper execution.

1 style = 2.5pts to 4.99pts

2 styles = 5.0pts to 10.00pts

- Crews should include various street dance styles from the list provided at the conclusion of this document.

Score ranges

Poor/Basic: 1.0pts to 2.5pts

Bellow Average: 2.51pts to 4.5pts

Average: 4.51pts to 6.5pts

Above Average: 6.51pts to 8.5pts

Superior: 8.51pts to 10pts

List of Deductions

Performance:

- **Major Fall -0.10 (per occurrence)**
 - A crewmember falls from a lift or support that is unrecoverable
 - A crewmember falls during the performance that is unrecoverable
- **Minor Fall -0.05 (per occurrence)**
 - A highly noticeable, accidental error during the performance that is recoverable
 - A crewmember stumbles, trips, or falls during the performance that is recoverable

Music:

- **Contains use of inappropriate racial or derogatory terminologies -0.20**
- Contains inappropriate language -0.10
- Routine length; not within accepted time **-0.10** (2:00min to 5:00min).
